If you haven't yet signed up, please do so as it's a great way for you to see all the great learning taking place at school.



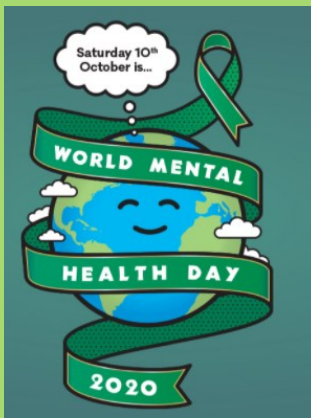
TLCs

For those parents new to Southwood, TLCs are Termly Learning Conversations (similar to Parent's Evenings) and they are held in the Autumn and Spring terms.

Normally at this time of year we would be sending home letters all about TLC appointments. This year, of course, TLCs will be different:

- Your child's teacher will telephone you to talk about how your child has settled into school since September, what your child's behaviour has been like and whether your child is performing around the expectations of the current year (at this point in the year), below the expectations, or above the expectations
- You will receive a letter giving an approximate time for your appointment, which will take place in the last two weeks of this half term
- Your telephone TLC should last no longer than 10 minutes. If you have anything to discuss that needs a longer appointment time, please call the school office and Mrs Mathews will contact you
